- **Raffle Progress:** The Raffle Kick-off with mailing to Council and sales at Council Wurst and Beer Tasting Night on September 12<sup>th</sup> @ 7 p.m netted us \$165. Tickets are coming in slowly and we are seeing participation from our Council members as well as those of you in the Assembly. To date we have met payment for our printing and mailing fees and we almost have the prizes paid for. We still have a ways to go though and we you're your help. Please take a moment today and send in your ticket stubs and check. It would be nice that we don't find ourselves in November trying to struggle to meet the income we need for the budget to operate.
- **By-Laws Vote:** I distributed a template from Supreme for suggested Assembly By-Laws to the officers at our August meeting and everyone reviewed the changes at our September meeting. We will vote to approve the Assembly By-Laws on October 1<sup>st</sup>. Please be in attendance.
- **Steak Fry:** The Steak fry will be held on Sunday, November 22<sup>nd</sup> (Feast Day of St. Cecilia) at church. Start time is 2:00 p.m. following the Corporate Communion Mass (Council Anniversary) and our Honor Guard participation. November 22<sup>nd</sup> is our Council's Charter Anniversary and aligns with our Patron Saint's Feast Day. The Raffle Drawing will occur during the Steak fry.
- **Slight Budget Revisions:** At September's Assembly meeting we made some slight revisions to the annual budget in order to comply with the Draft By-Laws that were reviewed. These amendments were approved by those in attendance. The budget is once again included in this newsletter. Specifically, the changes are:
  - A new line-item for compensation for the Faithful Comptroller that amounts to 8% of the dues collected (\$68.00).
  - A new line item for compensation for the Faithful Purser totaling \$50.00
  - A new line item for a Relief Fund of \$100 (NOTE: last year's Disaster Fund is renamed Relief Fund)
  - Amounts reflected above were subtracted from the miscellaneous line-item in the budget. The Miscellaneous line was reduced from \$400 to \$182.
  - There has been no overall change in the size of the Assembly Budget. The budget remains at \$200 for the FY 2009/2010 year.
