The account balance was revised to reflect actuals as of July 1st (budget start) as well as the downward correction of name badge costs and upward correction of Miscellaneous costs. The approved budget accompanies this newsletter on the last page. It was voted that the Assembly Faithful Purser, Gordon Wright shall provide a comparison of expenditures vs. budget line items to the Faithful Trustees on a monthly basis. Other Budget Highlights:
 - Our new annual dues will be \$25 starting with the December billing to members for CY 2010.
 - Established an ongoing Flag Fund that will pay to replace the US flag on the Church flagpole.
 - Established one major raffle fundraiser to fund all Assembly Programs
