SCHOLARSHIP OBJECTIVES:

1. To recognize graduating high school students, college and vocational students who are parishioners of St. Cecilia Church, Glen Carbon who demonstrate the ability and character necessary to obtain a college or technical/vocational education.
2. To encourage individual improvement and dedication to St. Cecilia Church and our community.

ELIGIBILITY RULES:

1. The scholarship applicant must be a registered parishioner of St. Cecilia Church, Glen Carbon, Illinois 62034 or the Catholic son or daughter of a St. Cecilia Council Knights of Columbus member in good standing who is not a registered parishioner of St. Cecilia Church
2. The scholarship applicant must be a practicing Catholic.
3. Applicant for the scholarship must be in the final year of high school and meeting graduation requirements.
4. Scholarship must be used for the academic year for which it is rewarded.
5. If a recipient drops out of college or vocational for any reason, St. Cecilia KofC Council 13216 reserves the right to terminate the scholarship contract and refuse payment of any remaining portion of the scholarship.
6. If a St. Cecilia Scholarship recipient terminates their membership from St. Cecilia Church, Glen Carbon, and Illinois for any reason, St. Cecilia KofC Council 13216 reserves the right to terminate the scholarship contract and refuse payment of any remaining portion of the scholarship.
7. Recipient must be a citizen of the United States of America.
8. Recipient will demonstrate hard work, and dedication to improvement of themselves.

AWARDING OF SCHOLARSHIP:

The scholarship program will offer one \$500 scholarship per scholarship recipient for the academic year applied for.

REVENUE SOURCE:

The scholarship program will be funded by St. Cecilia Knights of Columbus Council 13216, 155 North Main Street, Glen Carbon, Illinois 62034

METHOD OF PAYMENT:

The scholarship payments will be made payable to the accredited college or vocational school that the recipient of the award will attend. Installments will be paid in increments of \$250.00, one at the beginning of the 1st Semester and one at the beginning of the 2nd Semester, to ensure that the award be utilized in accordance with the guidelines of the scholarship program.

COLLEGES/UNIVERSITIES AND VOCATIONAL SCHOOLS:



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The scholarship award must be used at an accredited vocational institution, college or university. Accredited schools will be determined by one of the six regional accrediting associations.
